

THE PALM GAME

BEFORE TO PLAY :

You have to print the 12 coconuts on an adhesive paper and to fix it on a cardboard. After, you can cut the 12 Coconuts circles.

You have also to find 4 small monkey characters (Red, Yellow, Blue and Green) as the ones you have on the picture. If you haven't you can use (to test the game), every type of characters you have (and I'm sure you have too much Kinder surprises with plastic characters) :o))

MATERIAL :

A palm tree, 12 Coconuts circles and 4 plastic Monkey characters.

HOW CAN YOU PLAY?

When you are 2 players, each one takes 6 coconuts.

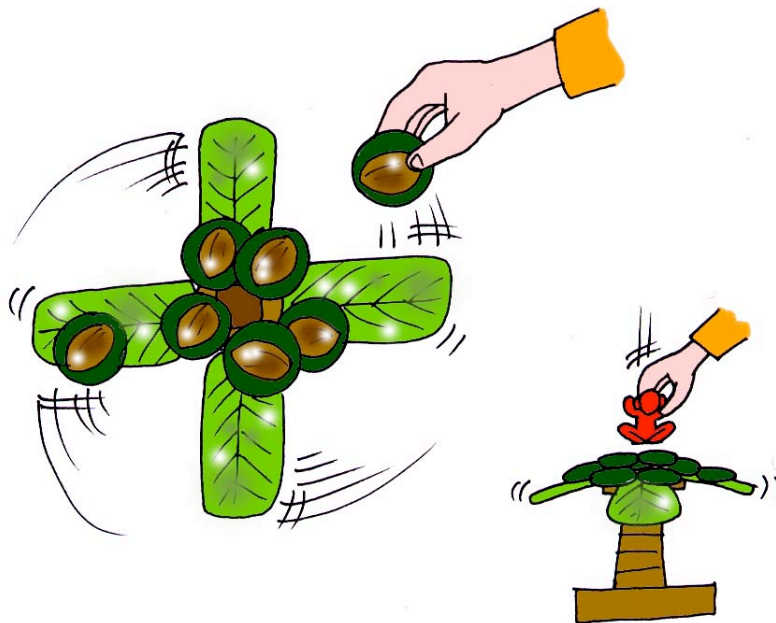
When you are 3 players, each one takes 4.

When you are 4 players, each one takes 3.

Each player has also one Monkey character.

The monkeys are playing, by placing all their coconuts on the top of the palm tree (which is turning!).

Each player and one by one will have to place **one of his coconuts** on the top of the palm tree (or on the palms, which is not easier!).



If nothing fall down, the player at left can do the same and so on (we play clockwise).
If something falls down, the player will have to takes all the falling down coconuts and stops his turn of game. The player at left can do the same and so on...

When a player has no more Coconuts, he can try to place his Monkey character.

If something falls down, he will have to takes all the falling down coconuts and stops his turn of game. The player at left can do the same and so on...

If nothing falls down he wins the game!

Note:

If the palm tree stops his rotation too soon, the game stops, and the winner is the one who have less Coconuts!
